



THIS BUILDING, at the northwest corner of Second Street and Third Avenue East, oldest church building in Duluth, has been the worship center of three congregations. Completed in 1871 by the congregation of the First Presbyterian Church, it later was used by St. Anthony de Padua Catholic Parish. Since 1923 it has been Messiah Lutheran Church. Although some features have been changed through remodeling, the appearance remains basically as it was when it was built.
