FAREWELL LITURGY

<u>Association Representative</u>: Our church family is constantly changing. People come and go. Babies are born. Children grow up. Persons move into our community and church life. Others leave us, moving to new experiences and new opportunities. It is important that we recognize these times of passage.

On June (1993), this congregation called Jody Ondich to serve as Associate Minister.

A.R.: Do you offer your encouragement for the continued ministry here, and on the relationship with those who serve as ministerial leaders?

Jody: I do, with the help of God.

The member churches of the wider church hold each of you in prayer. We pledge our support in the transitions signified in this service.
