Dear Dr. Halfaker;

As per your request I have had a long talk with Mr. Harry Iverson about what should be done to the organ at Pilgrim church to help it tonaly. The first thing he said was, What the organ should have is a new exposed principal chorus. I said yes this would be nice but, now we are talking in the ten to fifteen thousand dollar bracket and I'M sure there not intrested in spending this kind of money. Then he said, well if you would put a three rank mixture in the great, this would be a big help. He then said you know I proposed to do this to that organ some time ago, but they just never saw the way clear to do it. I asked him if he would write you a letter about this, but he said he just cant see well enough to write anymore, but said I could quote him on his recomendations.


The choir division could stand some improvements also, as there is a lot of borrowing done in that division. However there isnt enough room in the organ space to do much there, so if we were to improve that very much we would have to go to an exposed positiv division, and this would get costly again.

The thing the organ needs most is some upper work, and the best way to get started with this, without to much cost, is to install a three rank mixture in the great. This mixture should be a 15th, 19th and 22nd with two breaks in it, one at pipe number 23 and the other at pipe number 43.

This mixture could be installed in the pilgrim organ for a total cost of \$2,790.00. It would take about six months to get delivery on this from the Moller company. If you should care to go ahead with this let me know and I'll draw up a contract for same. In the contract we would request 25% down with the order and the balance when the job is complete.
