



THE FIRST CONGREGA-
tional church in Duluth was lo-
cated on the northeast corner of
First avenue east and Second
street. The church which may be
seen at Third avenue east is now
the Finnish Evangelical church,
but in 1870 was the First Presby-
terian church. The Congregational
church, with the spire removed, is
now the white garage on the
southeast corner of First street
and Eighth avenue. For a year it
served as the synagogue of Du-
luth's orthodox Jewry.

Specification for Decorating of Pilgrim Congregational Church.
The decorator shall furnish all scaffolding tools , implements and materials. To properly prepare all plastered walls and ceilings in the main Auditorium and Sanctuary and to decorate same in watercolors in designs as per sketches now ~~accepted~~ by the Ladies of the Church. The ground colors to be the same as the present was when new, The two front Vestibules shall be decorated in flat oil colors, the walls to be properly prepared and receive two coats of paint in colors to match church. The two rear halls shall be painted two coats of lead and oil paint. All work shall be first class and upon completion be ~~accepable~~ to the committee having charge of the work. Special care shall be taking not to injure or mar any woodwork or furniture and to properly cover and protect all woodwork and furniture.

Gentlemen:

I agree to furnish the scaffolding, tools, implements and materials to properly prepare all plastered walls and ceiling, and to decorate in oil colors the main auditorium, sanctuary, and two front vestibules of Pilgrim Congregational Church; the plastering to be sized and receive two coats of oil paint, the last coat to be of the same shade as the former decoration when new and in flat finish; the fresco work to be as per sketches which have been heretofore furnished by me, and accepted by the Committee of Ladies of the Church, and all of the work shall be executed in first-class, artistic and workmanlike manner.

The rear halls shall be sized and painted with lead and oil in plain color.

I also agree to re-decorate the pipes of the pipe organ to conform with the decoration of the church, and to clean off the woodwork of the organ.

I also agree to tint one room damaged by fire in the basement, do the necessary outside painting and clean up and re-finish the pews damaged by chemicals, water and smoke, and also do the required whitewashing in the attic of the church.

All of the above shall be done in first-class, workmanlike manner, and to the satisfaction of the committee of Ladies from the Ladies Union of the Church and of the Building Grounds Committee of the Board of Trustees of the church and all scaffolding and materials not used shall be removed and the building left in good condition.
